## Cost associated with Yard Waste Rate Chart Below

### Yard Waste We Can Take ✓

- Brambles, brush & branches (up to 6" diameter)
- Clean lumber scraps (nails okay; no other metal items such as hangers)
- Garden trimmings, grass clippings & leaves
- Prunings & vines

### Yard Waste We Cannot Take ✗

- Beauty bark & sod
- Dirt & rocks
- Kitchen waste & food
- Noxious weeds (Examples: Scotch Broom, Ivy, Blackberry Vines, Knapweed, Tansy & Gorse)
- Painted & treated lumber
- Cedar fencing & boards
- Stumps

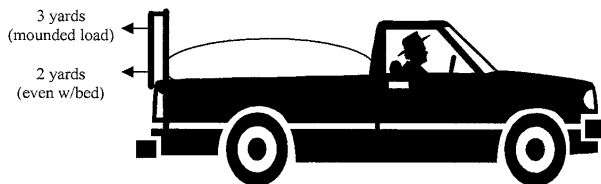

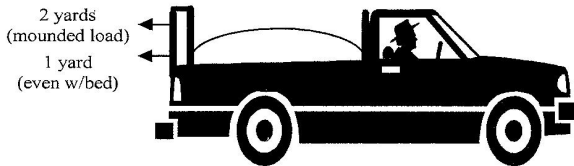

## Material Type Definitions

<b>Class I</b>	Dry loosely piled grass, leaves, brush, twigs & small branches (under 2" diameter), or any combination of the above. (Hint: dry twigs will "snap" when bent.)
<b>Class II</b>	Loosely piled grass, leaves, brush, medium branches & brush (under 4" diameter), lawn clippings, clean lumber scraps, or any combination of the above.
<b>Class III</b>	Wet grass, leaves, densely stacked branches & brush, or any combination of the above.

# Metals and Extra Recycling

We accept scrap metal and mixed recyclables at no charge!

## Now Accepting Recycling at the Drop-off Site:

Do you have extra recycling from a special clean out, a recent move or simply more than your cart can hold? Olympia garbage customers can now bring their extra recyclables at no charge to the Saturday Drop-off Site.

- Paper
- Aluminum and tin cans
- Plastic bottles, jugs, dairy tubs
- Plastic rigid flower pots
- Plastic buckets
- Glass bottles

### Metals We Can Take ✓

- Car parts (whole removable parts only; doors, fenders, motors, etc.)
- Fencing
- Outdoor furniture
- Posts
- Tanks (see restrictions)
- Tools
- Wheels
- Wire

### Metals We Cannot Take ✗

- Appliances
- Batteries
- Garbage
- Household tin cans
- Items containing hazardous fluids
- Metal mixed with plastic
- Paint cans
- Tires
- Vehicles
- Wood

### Metals Restrictions

#### Fluids

All units containing fluids, such as oil, hydraulics, transmission fluids, gases, etc., must be properly drained.

#### Engines

All engines must be drained with pans off and filters removed.

#### Transmissions

All transmissions must be drained of fluid, pans off and no torque converter.

#### Propane Cylinders

Valve stems must be removed from cylinders and preferably a hole punched in the cylinders.

#### Tanks

Any tank other than hot water tanks or water pressure tanks must have a large hole cut into each end of the tank for visual inspection.

*Customers are required to unload their own vehicles, so bring only what you can physically handle.*
